## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Heart in Diabetes (HiD) conference brings together world-renowned leaders in diabetes, obesity, and cardiorenal metabolic diseases to interpret state-of-the-art clinical data aimed at improving the care of complex patients with these comorbidities.

This year, the conference will continue to focus on cardiorenal and metabolic (CRM) diseases. The unique interactions between internationally recognized experts and community clinicians who manage patients with CRM/CKM conditions, fostering the development of evidence-based, holistic, and comprehensive management plans for these very high-risk patients.

Faculty and attendees come from a broad range of specialties, including endocrinology, cardiology, nephrology, obesity, hepatology, lipidology and primary care. By increasing knowledge and understanding of the pathophysiologic and clinical overlap between diabetes, obesity, cardiovascular disease (CVD), chronic kidney disease (CKD), heart failure (HF), MASLD and obesity, the HiD Congress equips clinicians with strategies and tools to improve the care of people with multiple cardiorenal and metabolic disorders.
