He is Deputy Editor of *Circulation*, Senior Editor of *Diabetes and Vascular Disease Research* and co-editor of the textbook: *Diabetes in Cardiovascular Disease: A Companion to Braunwald's Heart Disease*. Dr. McGuire has authored/co-authored over 280 peer-reviewed manuscripts, reviews, editorials and book chapters.
